

**Legislative Petitions:
The Ten Thousand Name Petition***

We have received a number of responses to our requests for information about these lists and will share a few of them with you this time and more later. (Page references are to the first page number listed for the petitions which corresponds to the penciled page numbers apparently added by Archives staff.)

Marty Hiatt of Loudoun has identified page 79 (Loudoun), page 103 (Loudoun Fairfax border), page 207 (Loudoun), and page 247 (Loudoun or Fairfax). Note: We have only published pages 79 and 103 to date.

Nancy Samuelson of Eastford, Connecticut, has identified page 9 and page 11a as containing Pittsylvania County names.

Both Jefferson Moak of Philadelphia and Jean Lurvey of Springfield, Missouri, identified p.69 as the northeast quadrant of Halifax County. They have the following comments about some of the questionable names: Richard Staule is probably Stanley, Leonard is Kaling not Raling; David Cr— is probably David Crews; Thomas Pass, Robert Sharman and Nathaniel Wooten are correct; Thomas Palmore/Dalmore is probably Thomas Palmer; John Ward is John Wood.

Jean Lurvey also found Halifax names on pages 47, 67, 71.

Virginia Pence of Rochester, Minnesota, suggests that some of the names (Moses Wright, Thomas Shelton, John Wright) on page 31 are connected with Amherst County rather than Pittsylvania County.

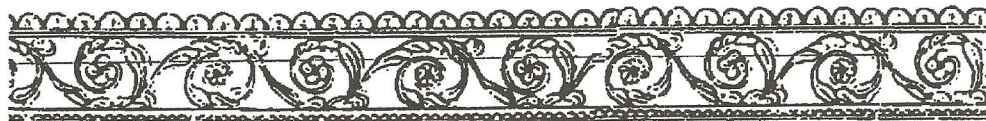
Readers should take these and other identifications as clues only. These lists were not generated within a county in the same way a tax list was generated. Churches frequently attracted members from across more than one county
